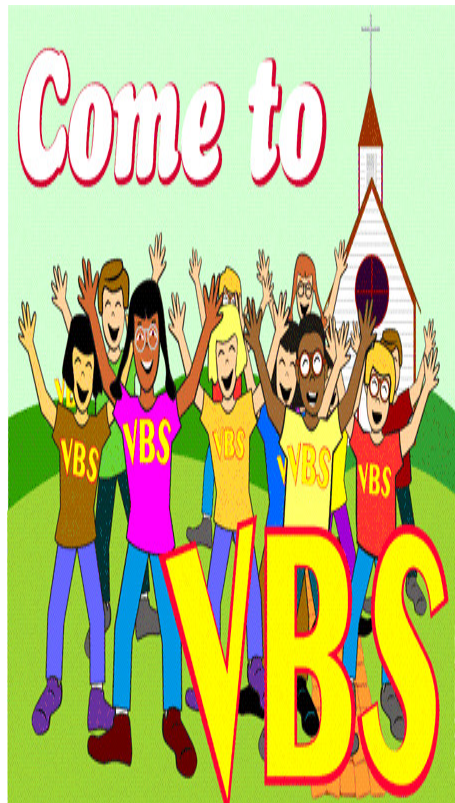
provements on the fence & built new steps leading into our cemetery.
